One of the missions of this winery is the preservation of culture: the people, the local traditions; viticultural as well as culinary and more. The Y Tu wines are made from grapes hand-harvested from small, mixed plots: anachronisms in a time of profitable monocrops and tax-haven wineries. While autochthonal plantings have been pulled up plot by plot in favor of safe, consultant-approved varieties, the families of Grantias are celebrating these small, mixed plots that hold- and survive by- the knowledge of generations. The grapes, red, white, gris (and even many in between) are co-harvested into small collection containers that are lightly stomped in the vineyard to initiate fermentation until they are brought to the cellar where a second surface stomping contributes to the partial whole cluster fermentation.

## Agriculture & Vinification

### ¿Y Tú de Quién Eres? Tinto

- Hand-picked into small baskets
- Fermentation: vatted and lightly stomped in the vineyard, transferred to small 5hl tanks in the cellar
- Aging: in tinaja, inox steel tank, and old barrels
- Annual Production: 5300 bottles

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
